

THE PUSH-AND-PULL OF PARENTING

Reflection/discussion guide

Do this activity on your own, as a couple or in your small group and discuss together.

- There are lots of things vying for your attention, time and energy. The video addressed three main areas that push-and-pull you in parenting. How do you feel decision-making is pushing or pulling you? Your schedule? And technology?
- Having a solid foundation based upon Psalm 46:10 is vital to your relationship with God. And that foundation will then impact your relationship with your child. What needs to change in your decision-making, schedule and technology in order to first push to be still and know God?
- The ultimate goal in parenting is to raise lifelong interdepedent followers of Jesus.

 1 Peter 1:15-16 reminds us what it looks like to be holy, or set apart. What is your prayer for your child in how he/she will be set apart? What is your prayer for yourself, as a parent, in how you will be set apart?
- Take a look at each individual relationship with each of your children. What would
 quality time look like for each child? It probably looks different for each child, so take
 time to personalize it. And how can you potentially get more quantity time in with
 each child?
- Think about a time you had to pull together as a family. Why did you have to pull together? What could you have done differently? If you are currently going through a time that you need to pull together as a family, think about what that could or should look like. In good AND tough times, you and your family can draw closer than ever before.
- You are probably doing a LOT of good and even great things with your time, energy
 and attention. But how do you make the tough decision of what you need to pull out
 of in order to have the best? Make the hard decision as to what you need to pull out
 of. Be specific and take a risk to say, "No" to something so you can say, "Yes!" to the
 best.
